POLICY

	Title: Antique and Permanent Vintage License Plates

Effective Date: October 25, 2007	Revision Date: July 1, 2024
Authority: Code of Virginia § 46.2-694, 46.2-711,	46.2-712, et seq., and 46.2-730

Policy:

On receipt of an application and evidence that the applicant owns, leases, or has regular use of another passenger car, autocycle, or motorcycle, DMV will issue permanent antique license plates to owners of antique motor vehicles and antique trailers for a one-time fee of \$50.

On receipt of an application and evidence that the applicant owns, leases, or has regular use of another passenger car, autocycle, or motorcycle, DMV may authorize and register as permanent or for general use on antique motor vehicles and antique trailers vintage Virginia license plates provided the plate presented for use by the customer is:

- Manufactured for issuance in Virginia prior to 1976,
- Designed for use without decals,
- Embossed with or are of the same model year of issue as the antique vehicle or antique trailer being registered.

Customers must maintain <u>minimum liability insurance</u> if they have permanent antique license plates, permanent vintage license plates, or general use vintage license plates. **END REVISION>>>>**

DEFINITIONS

ANTIQUE LICENSE PLATE – Permanent license plates issued by DMV for use on antique vehicles or trailers that are designed with either a black background with white lettering, or yellow background with blue lettering.

ANTIQUE MOTOR VEHICLE OR TRAILER - Any motor vehicle or trailer that is 25 model years old or older as of January 1 of the current year and is owned solely as a collector's item.

VINTAGE LICENSE PLATES – Virginia license plates presented by the customer for use on an antique vehicles or trailers that were designed for use without decals, that are embossed with or are of the same year as the vehicle being registered and were manufactured before 1976.

GENERAL USE VEHICLE - Any vehicle that the customer drives on a daily basis that is not registered with antique or permanent vintage plates. The customer must certify that they own, lease, or have access to, a general use passenger car, autocycle, or motorcycle before DMV will register an antique vehicle or trailer with antique or vintage plates.

OVERVIEW

ANTIQUE PLATES:

- Antique plates are available for antique motor vehicles, autocycles, motorcycles, and trailers.
- A permanent antique registration requires a one-time registration fee (shown on <u>VSA 10B</u>).

- All antique vehicles and trailers with **permanent** antique or vintage registrations (not general use) state "LIMITED USE" on the registration and are subject to the following use restrictions:
 - Vehicle and trailer use is restricted to participation in club activities, exhibits, tours, parades, and similar activities, as well as for occasional pleasure driving within 250 miles of the owner's residence.
 - Vehicle and trailer use is restricted to carrying or transporting passengers, personal effects, or other antique motor vehicles being transported for show purposes.
 - The vehicle or trailer may be driven on the highways of the Commonwealth in order to obtain repairs or maintenance, to test its operation, or for the purpose of selling it.
 And
 - The vehicle or trailer must remain solely a collector's item and in no event be used for general transportation.

VINTAGE PLATES:

- Plates used as vintage license plates MUST be originally issued by Virginia. They cannot be reproductions.
- Vintage plates are provided by the customer and are subject to quality inspection and approval by DMV prior to use on the vehicle or trailer.
- DMV will not accept more than one application for a set of vintage license plates having the same number and year.
 - A set of vintage plates may share the same plate number as a single set of standard passenger plates.
- Vintage plates may be issued for antique vehicles or trailers as either permanent registrations or general use registrations.
 - Permanent vintage registrations are subject to the same restrictions as antique license plate registrations.
 - General use vintage registrations:
 - Allow unrestricted driving privileges,
 - Must be renewed every year, every other year, or every three years
 - Require payment of the standard registration fees,
 - Display month and year decals on the vintage plates, and
 - Must obtain an annual safety inspection sticker.

CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS

0

- 1. For vehicles not yet titled in Virginia, submit the Application for Certificate of Title and Registration (<u>VSA-17A</u>), other required ownership documents and fees for titling a motor vehicle.
- 2. Submit one of the following completed and signed applications:
 - Application for Registration, (VSA 14)
 - License Plate Application, (VSA 10) to apply for souvenir, personalized, or special license plates.

<<<<REVISION

- 3. Submit the Antique and Vintage License Plate Certification (<u>VSA 10B</u>) along with the required application when applying for either antique or vintage plates. **END REVISION>>>>**
 - Certification must be with original signatures (no photocopies).
 - Customer must certify they own, or have regular use of, another passenger car, autocycle, or motorcycle and that the vehicle, autocycle, or motorcycle is capable of being safely operated on Virginia roadways.
- 4. Submit for inspection the license plates to be used on the antique vehicle or trailer when applying for vintage plates.
- 5. Pay the required fees.

FRONT COUNTER CSR

- 1. For vehicles not yet titled in Virginia, process a title transaction in accordance with <u>VLIC-3.000</u> before registering the vehicle and issuing license plates.
- 2. Verify accurate completion of the VSA-14 or VSA 10 application.

- 3. Verify accurate completion of the VSA-10B certification.
- 4. Determine the type of antique plates being applied for:
 - Antique permanent
 - Vintage permanent
 - Vintage general use

NOTE: Inspect all vintage plates presented by the customer to ensure they are authentic, were issued in Virginia, are in acceptable condition and legible (readable) for use on the vehicle.

- 5. If multiple registrations exist for the vehicle, ask the customer which plates they wish to retain.
 - Transactions will not process in the system if multiple registrations/plates exist for the vehicle or trailer for which the VSA 10B certification must be submitted.
- 6. Review the printed registration card to ensure that "LIMITED USE" appears on the left side of the card and give the registration to the customer.
 - For error messages, double-check the title number and re-key the transaction.
- 7. Continue processing the registration in accordance with <u>VLIC-4.000</u>.

POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Owners of antique motor vehicles, autocycles, motorcycles, or trailers registered with antique license plates who are convicted of violating the antique license plate statute (<u>46.2-730</u>) are subject to (i) a Class 4 misdemeanor and (ii) revocation of the license plates registered to the antique motor vehicle, autocycle, motorcycle, or trailer involved in the violation for a period of five years from the date the conviction data is received by DMV.
- Antique plates are issued by DMV, vintage plates are provided by the customer.
- The registration card for a vehicle or trailer with a permanent registration (antique or vintage plates) will indicate that the vehicle or trailer is for "LIMITED USE."
- A reissue of lost or stolen antique plates is \$10 (refer to <u>VLIC-4.115</u>).
- License plates for passenger vehicles and trailers issued in or after 1973 are not eligible for use as vintage plates because the year of issuance is not embossed on the plate. However, motorcycle owners may be able to obtain vintage motorcycle plates, with embossed years, for 1973, 1974, and 1975.
- Passenger vehicles and trailers manufactured in or after 1973 and motorcycles manufactured in or after 1976 are NOT eligible for vintage plates. Owners of those vehicles must purchase antique or standard license plates.
- Replica vehicles do not automatically qualify for antique plates based on the model year. Replica vehicles are
 registered and issued license plates based on the year the replica vehicle was assembled, not the vehicle's
 model year (refer to <u>VLIC-3.350</u>).
- One set of passenger vehicle license plates issued after 1973 may share the same plate number as a vintage plate. One set of motorcycle plates issued after 1976 may share the same plate number as a vintage motorcycle plate.
