Title: Multi-Staged Motor Home, Application for Title

Effective Date: March 14, 1990 Revision Date:

Authority: AAMVA Policy Position, RTVDM 01, #4 September 1997

Policy

DMV shall title multi-staged motor homes using the **vehicle identification number** (VIN) that is assigned by the First Manufacturer on the Manufacturer's Certificate or Statement of Origin (MCO/MSO). The first manufacturer VIN shall be the only VIN recorded on the vehicle record.

DMV shall title multi-staged motor homes using the **make** and **model year** recorded on the Manufacturer Certificate or Statement of Origin (MCO/MSO) that is issued by the second stage Manufacturer, which will be the only make and model year recorded on the vehicle record.

DEFINITIONS

Multi-Staged Motor Home – A motor vehicle that requires manufacturing by separate manufacturers to produce a complete motor home.

First Stage Manufacturer – Manufacturer of the chassis assembly who assigns and affixes a vehicle identification number (VIN) to the vehicle.

Second Stage Manufacturer – The final stage manufacturer who manufactures the body, assigns the make and model year, and installs the interior finish.

CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS

- Submit the following:
 - Completed Application for Certificate of Title and Registration (<u>VSA-17A</u>).
 - Ownership documents:
 - For a new motor home:
 - Certificate or Statement of Origin (MCO/MSO) from First Stage Manufacturer for the vehicle chassis.
 - Certificate or Statement of Origin (MCO/MSO) from the Second Stage Manufacturer for the motor home body,

- Dealer Invoice, or Bill of Sale. END REVISION>>>>
- For a used motor home:
 - Virginia or out-of-state certificate of title.
- 2. Other titling requirements in accordance with <u>VLIC-3.000</u>.
- 3. Pay fees (only one title will be produced)
 - Title fee
 - Sales and Use Tax
 - Registration fees

FRONT COUNTER CSR

- 1. Verify that applicant has completed the VSA-17A correctly.
- 2. Verify that the customer has an approved proof of address document, when applicable. (Refer to DMV-177.)
- 3. Check the ownership documents for authenticity (see authenticity manual).
- Process the title.
 - a. Enter the VIN that is shown on the chassis MCO/MSO from the first stage manufacturer.
 - b. Enter the make and model year that is shown on the MCO/MSO for the motor home body from the second stage manufacturer.

Example:

First Stage Manufacturer MCO/MSO Vehicle Information	
MAKE:	FORD
YEAR:	1990
VIN OF CHASSIS:	0123456789TESTING

Second Stage Manufacturer MCO/MSO Vehicle Information	
MAKE:	OAKWOOD
YEAR:	1991

- Title would display VIN 01234567TESTING, vehicle make as Oakwood Motor Home, and a vehicle model year of 1991.
- 5. Continue processing title in accordance with VLIC-3.000.

- Do NOT use phrases like:
 - "You have everything you need, just go to a CSC and they will issue your document."
- Use phrases such as:
 - "The documents you have listed sound like they may be acceptable: The CSC will make the final determination of your eligibility to receive your Virginia title and/or registration card."
