# **POLICY**

Title: Non-Negotiable Title- Record a Lien

Effective Date: August 25, 2013 Revision Date: July 1, 2017

Authority: Code of Virginia § 46.2-602, 58.1-2403

### Policy:

#### <<<<REVISION

DMV shall issue a nonnegotiable title for vehicles purchased in Virginia by a nonresident to allow the purchaser to satisfy lienholder requirements for recording the lien when a vehicle is to be titled and registered in another state, provided:

- The vehicle was purchased in Virginia
- The applicant is NOT a resident of VIRGINIA
- Title is being issued for the purpose of recording a lien (Virginia or non-Virginia lienholder).
- The vehicle is to be registered in another state.

Nonnegotiable titles issued to record a lien are not transferrable.

Nonnegotiable titles issued to record a lien cannot be registered and are therefore not subject to sales and use tax (SUT). **END REVISION>>>>** 

# **Exceptions:**

A nonnegotiable title issued to record a lien may be transferred, and a new nonnegotiable title issued only to qualified heirs or survivors with rights of survivorship upon the passing of the vehicle owner.

### **CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Submit a completed Application for Certificate of Title and Registration VSA 17A.
- 2. Submit acceptable proof of ownership:
  - An MCO or MSO, for vehicles purchased new,
  - A Virginia or out-of-state title and dealer invoice/bill of sale, for vehicles purchase used.
- 3. Pay the title fee.

#### FRONT COUNTER CSR

- 1. Verify submission of a completed and signed VSA 17A.
- 2. Verify submission of required proof of ownership document:
  - MCO/MSO, for vehicles purchased new
  - Virginia or out-of-state title, for vehicles purchased used.
- 3. Verify that a lien is to be recorded for the vehicle.

- 4. Advise the customer that a nonnegotiable title does not allow the vehicle to be registered, or ownership to be transferred in Virginia.
  - This type of non-negotiable title is issued as evidence of ownership and to allow the purchaser to satisfy lienholder requirements for recording the lien when a vehicle is to be titled and registered in another state.
- 5. Continue processing the original title in accordance with VLIC-3.000.
  - Vehicles issued nonnegotiable titles for the purpose of recording a lien when the vehicle is to be titled out-ofstate cannot be registered, and are therefore exempt from SUT at time of titling (refer to <u>VLIC-4.620</u>).

- To assist customers with questions regarding nonnegotiable titles, or in identifying situations when a nonnegotiable would apply, refer to the Nonnegotiable Title Eligibility table. **END REVISION>>>>**
- Do NOT promise the acceptability of documents to customers.
- Do NOT use phrases like:
  - "You have everything you need, just go to a CSC and they will issue your document."
  - Use phrasing such as:
    - "The documents you have listed sound like they may be acceptable: The CSC will make the final determination of your eligibility to receive your Virginia title and/or registration card."

### POINTS TO REMEMBER

- To issue a nonnegotiable title for purposes of recording a lien, the following conditions must be met:
  - Vehicle was purchased in Virginia,
  - Purchaser is NOT a resident of Virginia,
  - Title is issued for the purpose of recording a lien (Virginia or non-Virginia lienholder), and
  - o Vehicle is to be registered in another state.
- Vehicles titled as nonnegotiable:
  - Cannot be registered and are therefore not subject to SUT. The purchaser will pay SUT in the state where the vehicle is titled and registered.
  - Are not transferrable unless the owner becomes deceased, in which case a nonnegotiable title may be issued
    to qualified heirs and surviving joint owners with right of survivorship (refer to <u>VLIC-3.505</u>).
