<b>Policy:</b> <<<<<REVISION DMV will release a seized/confiscated vehicle stop placed on a vehicle record by law enforcement provided that an order from the Commonwealth's Attorney releasing the vehicle along with either a bill of sale from the Internal Revenue Service or auction bill of sale from the sheriff is submitted at time of titling. <b>END REVISION</b> >>>>>

### CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS

1. Submit:
  - An order from the Commonwealth's Attorney releasing the vehicle clearly stating in no uncertain terms that the vehicle was:
    - Released to the owner, or
    - Released to the lienholder, or
    - Sold at public auction.

**AND**

  - A bill of sale from the Internal Revenue Service,

**OR**

A bill of sale from the sheriff when sold at public auction.

  - "Application For Certificate Of Title And Registration", ([VSA-17A](#)) or "Application For Certificate Of Title - Manufactured Home", ([VSA-17B](#)).
  - Other requirements to title in accordance with [VLIC-3.000](#).

### FRONT COUNTER CSR

1. Verify submission of:
  - An order from the Commonwealth's Attorney releasing the vehicle,

**AND**

  - A bill of sale from the Internal Revenue Service,

**OR**

A bill of sale from the sheriff's office.

  - Completed and signed the [VSA-17A](#) or [VSA-17B](#).

2. Remove the seized/confiscated stop from vehicle record.
3. Continue processing the title in accordance with [VLIC-3.000](#).
  - If the vehicle is released to the lienholder, title it in the lienholder's name.
  - If sold at public auction, attach the disposition of vehicle from the Commonwealth's Attorney and a bill of sale from the sheriff's office that conducted the sale.
