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CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. For vehicles not yet titled in Virginia, submit a completed and signed Application for Certificate of Title and Registration in accordance with VLIC-3.000.
- Submit a completed Emergency Vehicle License Plates-Vehicle Registration Application (<u>VSA-125</u>) with the appropriate certification section completed and signed.
- Submit appropriate fee(s).

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FRONT COUNTER CSR

- For vehicles not yet titled in Virginia, process a title transaction in accordance with <u>VLIC-3.000</u> before registering the vehicle and issuing license plates.
- 2. Verify completion of all required sections of the VSA-125.
 - See <u>Guide to Firefighting and Other Emergency Vehicle License Plates</u>
- 3. Determine the appropriate license plates to be issued according to the VSA 125.

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² Commercial and privately owned EMS vehicles which are operated For-Hire are not required to obtain Operating Authority.

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- 4. Verify completion of insurance certification on the VSA-125. END REVISION>>>>
- 5. Issue the following:
 - Plates
 - Decals (when applicable)
 - Registration card
- 6. Collect the appropriate fees
 - No registration fee is due pursuant to Va. Code § 46.2-649.1:1 for volunteer EMS vehicles owned
 or used exclusively by a volunteer fire department or volunteer EMS agency (may be co-owned by
 local government agency).
- 7. Prepare documents with correct barcode coversheet and place in appropriate area for document preparation.

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DMV CUSTOMER CONTACT CENTER ACTIONS

- 1. Do NOT promise the acceptability of documents to customers required to come to DMV.
- 2. Do NOT use phrases like:
 - o "You have everything you need, just go to a CSC and they will issue your plates."
- 3. Do use phrasing such as:
 - "The documents you have listed sound like they may be acceptable: The CSC will make the final determination of your eligibility to receive your registration and plates."

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POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Permanent Emergency Vehicle Services plates issued at no fee (EVS) for use on volunteer EMS vehicles cannot be reissued, renewed, or transferred (original issue only).
- Permanent-billable Emergency Vehicle Services plates issued with a registration fee (EVSF) for use on commercial or privately owned EMS vehicles can be reissued, renewed, or transferred for a fee.
