## **POLICY**

Title: Independent Dealer-Operator Recertification Exam

Effective Date: 01/15/2011 Revision Date: July 1, 2024

Authority: Code of VA: §§ 46.2-1503.4, 46.2-1506.1, 46.2-1586, and 46.2-1589

**Policy:** Virginia DMV is authorized to administer the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board (MVDB) Dealer-Operator Recertification exam.

#### <<<<REVISION

- This exam may ONLY be taken by a qualified Independent Dealer Operator.
- This exam is only administered in English, using SecuriTest. There is no audio for this exam, and a paper exam is not available. END REVISION>>>>

## **BACKGROUND**

#### <<<<REVISION

Virginia Code requires independent motor vehicle dealer-operators to recertify their dealer operator certificate of qualification every 2 years. The MVDB sends a recertification notice to independent dealer-operators in advance of their recertification deadline date.

Independent motor vehicle dealer-operators may recertify their dealer-operator certificate of qualification by either:

- Completing an Independent Dealer-Operator course of study with an outside vendor, OR
- Passing a Dealer-Operator Recertification exam at DMV.
  - **NOTE:** The exam is offered on demand, there are no restrictions to the number of exam attempts, and the \$50 fee is paid each exam attempt. **END REVISION>>>>**

**IMPORTANT:** Do not confuse the independent dealer-operator recertification exam in this procedure with dealer-operator qualification testing for first-time dealer-operator licenses (refer to VLIC-7.005).

# **CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS**

# <<<<REVISION

- 1. Present the "Dealer Operator/Salesperson Qualification Test Application" (MVDB 57). END REVISION>>>>
- 2. Present a valid photo ID issued by a U.S. state, jurisdiction, or territory.
- 3. Pay test fee.
  - a. The test fee is non-refundable.
- 4. Comply with exam requirements in the test area.

# FRONT COUNTER CSR

# <<<<REVISION

- 1. Collect the "Dealer Operator/Salesperson Qualification Test Application" (MVDB 57) and a valid photo ID.
  - If the customer does not have a valid photo ID, do not initiate the exam.
- Compare and verify name and photo on the customer's license with person presenting the MVDB 57. END REVISION>>>>
- 3. Initiate the qualification transaction in the system.
- 4. Collect the test fee.
  - a. The test fee is non-refundable and required with each attempt.

# **KNOWLEDGE TESTING CSR PROCESS**

- 1. Call customer to examiner console.
- 2. Verify exam to be administered with customer.

#### <<<<REVISION

- Compare and verify name and photo on the customer's license with person presenting the "Dealer Operator/Salesperson Qualification Test Application" (MVDB 57). END REVISION>>>>
  - If the customer does not have a valid driver's license or identification card, do not administer the exam.
     Advise customer that a valid government issued photo identification driver's license is required to take the exam. END REVISION>>>>
- 4. Review exam testing area requirements with the customer.
  - Must not use a cell phone in exam area.
  - Must not leave the test area for any reason.
  - Must not use notes or any reference material during the exam.
  - Must not seek assistance with exam from anyone other than a DMV employee.
  - Must not talk during the exam.
  - No audio or written options exist for this exam.

## <<<<REVISION

- 5. Once the customer has finished the exam, complete the DMV section of the MVDB 57:
  - a. If the customer PASSES the exam.
    - i. Recall the transaction and record the test results.
    - ii. On the MVDB 57, write the date, "Passed" and stamp and initial the form.
    - iii. Inform the customer that they will receive additional correspondence from the MVDB.
    - iv. Return the MVDB 57, "Certificate of Qualification" receipt, and photo ID to the customer.
  - b. If the customer FAILS the exam:
    - i. Recall the transaction and record the test results.
    - ii. Stamp and initial the MVDB 57 and write "Failed".
    - iii. Advise the customer the exam can be taken as many times as the customer wants, and a \$50 fee is paid at each attempt.
    - iv. Return the MVDB 57 and photo ID to the customer. NOTE: The MVDB 57 may be reused once if the customer wishes to retake the examination. After the second use, the customer must complete a new MVDB 57. END REVISION>>>>

#### POINTS TO REMEMBER

MVDB determines and notifies those dealers who are required to recertify.

#### <<<<REVISION

- This exam is offered in English only. There is no audio for this exam and a written exam is not available.
- The exam recertification exam fee is collected by DMV, not by the MVDB. This fee is non-refundable.
- Applicant must submit the MVDB 57 and a valid photo ID to be eligible to test.
  - o If the customer does not a valid photo ID, do not administer the exam. END REVISION>>>>
